Bay Village Lacrosse Club

BVLC is a not-for-profit corporation and a 501(c)(3) public charity. BVLC administers the Bay Lacrosse Youth Programs.

An ideal squad consists of 18-20 players, so we will split teams into two or more squads depending on the number of players. This is usually an A/B split.

Indoor practices start in early November with one hour per week at Force Sports in Westlake (on Detroit near Clague). Girls will practice Wednesday evenings, and (generally) boys on Friday. We know that kids (and parents!) have other activities, so it is OK if you can't make all or even any of the indoor sessions.

Outdoor practices will start in March, weather permitting, with two to three practices or games per week though the end of the season in late May. Generally, teams play 8-10 games plus two tournaments. Most games are in Northeast Ohio, with home games at Bay Stadium, Bradley or Cahoon.

2017-2018 BVLC Fees

Fees provide for indoor time, balls, goals, refs and tournaments. The fees per age group are as follows for 2017-2018:

- 7th & 8th Grade Boys \$250
- 5th & 6th Grade Boys \$250
- 3rd & 4th Grade Boys \$200
- 7th & 8th Grade Girls \$250
- 5th & 6th Grade Girls \$250
- 3rd & 4th Grade Girls \$200

In addition, for insurance purposes players must join and be an active member of US Lacrosse, ~\$30 per year. www.uslacrosse.org. You must have your US Lacrosse membership information to register.

Players must also purchase a uniform kit, about \$70 per player. You can use the same uniform every year (assuming she/he does not out grow it). Uniforms and apparel information will be made available for order at a later time.
